Academic Word:

assessment (n) /əˈses.mənt/

Meaning:

Examples:

the process of testing someone's knowledge, ability or skills



Collocations: 'to carry out an assessment' 'to give an assessment'

'a quick assessment'

At Brunel Language Centre students have regular assessments to check their learning progress.

General English Expression: 'once in a blue moon'

Meaning:

This means that something does not happen very often (e.g. perhaps once or twice a year).

Example:

I used to go to the cinema every week but nowadays I only go once in a blue moon.

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
