Meaning: large in size, value or importance

Collocations: 'substantial amount of...'
'substantial difference between...'

Examples: The findings show a substantial difference between the ideas of men and women.

General English Expression: 'From time to time'

Meaning: This is a way of saying that you do something sometimes.

Example: I like Indian food, so from time to time I go to Brick Lane in East London where you can get excellent Indian food.
